Dear Parents:

I want to let you know about a great educational opportunity for your child. Northwest Florida Ballet's downtown Fort Walton Beach facility is also the home of NFB Académie, a groundbreaking academic and artistic education program for third through eighth grades. We will hold auditions for our 2018-2019 Third Grade Class (currently second grade students), and would like to invite your child to participate.

The Académie is a free school. There is no tuition, and prior dance experience is not required. Selection is based entirely upon the student's potential and desire to dance. Certified Okaloosa County school teachers ensure that academic training is rigorous. In addition to their normal academic classes, students selected for the program will have concentrated daily instruction in ballet as well as weekly instruction in art, music, and French. It is a proven fact that training in the arts helps children learn faster, retain longer, and develop positive self-esteem. Learning and practicing the arts requires a level of commitment, discipline, and perseverance often associated with sports. So, it should come as no surprise that NFB Académie's test scores are consistently among the highest in the district. The NFB Académie has also been an A+ School since inception.


Auditions will be held on **Saturday, April 28th**, from 6:00-8:00 PM and **Sunday, April 29th** from 2:30-4:30 PM at the NFB Sybil Leberz Center for Dance Education, located at 310 Perry Avenue SE, at the intersection of Perry Avenue and Brooks Street in Fort Walton Beach. If your child would like to participate, please fill out the attached registration form to RSVP and include a photo of your child. We ask that the child arrive 30 minutes prior to the audition with a parent or responsible adult. The audition will last 1 ½ - 2 ½ hours. Parents should remain in the building throughout the process. Because of limited space, we ask that no more than two family members accompany the child. The prospective students should be prepared in the following manner:

1. Each student will audition with bare legs and bare feet, and should have their hair pulled out of their face
2. Boys should wear a fitted T-shirt with either bike or gym shorts
3. Girls should wear a leotard (if already owned) or a 1 piece bathing suit
4. Each student should wear an outfit or some "cover-up" with shoes to the building and arrive in good hygiene

Attached is a registration form that we ask you to complete and either mail, email, fax, or hand deliver to our offices by April 26th to RSVP for your student. Please be sure to specify on the form which day you will be auditioning. Parents will be asked to remain in the lobby area where representatives of the Northwest Florida Ballet will be available to discuss this special program. Results will be mailed to you after the completion of ALL auditions. Parents of the students selected will also be sent information for an orientation to address all questions and concerns.
