



2021 Summer Workshop Studio Rules and Dress Code

- All summer workshop fees must be paid in full by the first day of class. All students will receive a schedule packet and a name tag on their first day of class. The name tag is their pass to enter class. Any student with a remaining balance will not be allowed to attend until the balance is paid.
- Students should bring a sack lunch. No microwaving allowed due to the limited lunchtime schedule. High school students may leave the NFB premises for lunch if a parent has filled out an off-campus lunch permission form. Students must always check in and out of the building.
- NO FOOD UPSTAIRS. Please be considerate and clean up your own messes. Bottled water is acceptable in the studios.
- No running or playing on the stairs, in the lobby, or in the studios. No students are allowed in the studios without an instructor present. No students are allowed to roam the building unattended.
- Instructors will take role for each class. If a student cannot participate in the class for any reason, they must observe the class. No students are allowed to stay in the dressing rooms during classes. If a student is ill, they must be picked up and taken home by a parent or guardian.
- Please treat all instructors with dignity and respect.
- NFB is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Keep your personal belongings safe! NFB offers lockers. Bring your own lock to use a locker and please take home your belongings at the end of each day. **Label all belongings.** There are hundreds of students in our building each day.
- Please abide by NFB Summer Workshop dress codes.
- Bring an exercise mat for Pilates & Dance Conditioning Classes.
- Students must remain in the NFB building during all workshop classes and rehearsals. Please check your student in and out of the building for any appointments and call if your student will not be able to attend class.
- Please pick up students promptly after classes end. Any student left after hours longer than 15 minutes will be charged a \$15 late fee.

COVID PROTOCOLS:

- Lobby will be closed to the public.
- Temperature/Wellness Check of students will be taken at the door by office staff- Masks must be worn in common use areas.
- Students will sanitize their hands and wait in designated class area before their instructor walks them to studio (stairs or lobby).

- While in the studio, teachers will make sure dancers remain in their designated dance area 6ft apart. Instructors will wear masks (and gloves if needed). Students should leave any personal belongings and shoes along the mirror or outside the studio door.

DRESS CODE:

Girls: solid color Leotard, full length convertible skin tone matching tights, ballet slippers, pointe shoes and skirt for pointe (Dancers not already on pointe will dance in ballet slippers during pointe class), hair in a bun. No excessive jewelry, scrunchies, wristbands or baggy clothing during ballet.

Boys: Black or white fitted t-shirt, black tights or black or gray leggings, white socks and ballet slippers.
